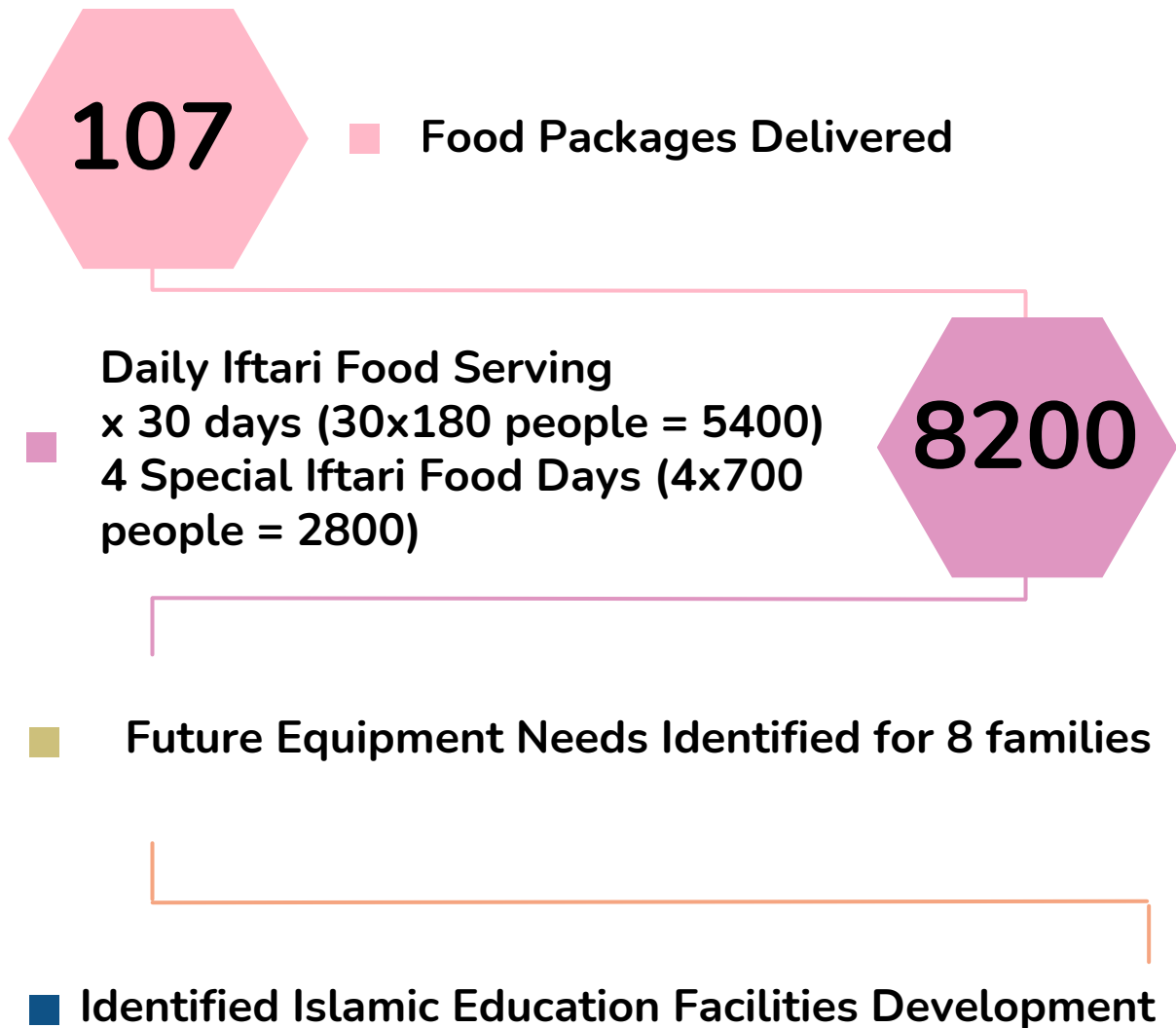

Ramadhan Project 2026 Gujar Khan Outcomes

February 2026 - March 2026

Total Beneficiaries: 8,315



Food Packages Delivered

Food Packages Delievered

Reward International UK delivered 107 food packages, of which 82 families directly supported.

Main beneficiaries who collected Food Packages expressed their following needs:

- Poverty - 34
- Disability - 14
- Widowed - 16
- Unemployed - 43

Providing food packages during Ramadan helped reduce immediate financial pressures and ensured beneficiaries could access meals throughout the fasting period. The support also contributed towards improving emotional wellbeing by showing community care and collective support during current challenging circumstances.



Islamic Education Development

Reward International UK has also explored the potential to extend Islamic tuition provision for children aged between 5 and 11.

As part of this development, the current facilities were reviewed and several areas were identified for improvement to enhance the learning environment.

These include the installation of shelving for books, whiteboards, fans and air conditioning units, as well as new carpet, refurbishment of toilet and washroom facilities, provision of drinking water dispensers and the purchase of appropriate reading desks for children.

In addition, we are looking into providing qualified teachers to support both afternoon and evening sessions. This would help to increase capacity and ensure consistent, high quality Islamic education is available to more children within the community.

We will be looking into raising further donations to support this expansion. This will enable the programme to continue developing, ensuring children benefit not only from strong Islamic education, but also from improved learning facilities that support their overall wellbeing, comfort and development.



Daily Iftari Food Serving

Alongside the food parcel distribution, the project delivered food for Iftari throughout Ramadan, supporting a total of 8,200 servings to beneficiaries with hot meals over the 30 days.

The Iftari Food created a welcoming and inclusive environment where individuals and families could come together to break their fast in a safe and supportive setting. These gatherings helped strengthen community relationships, reduce social isolation and encourage unity amongst local residents.

The initiative was particularly valuable for vulnerable individuals who may otherwise have struggled to access nutritious meals or participate in communal Ramadan activities. The project promoted both physical wellbeing and social connection during Ramadan.

Equipment Donations

We also identified a clear need to strengthen skills development opportunities within the local community through the provision of practical resources.

In particular, the purchase of computers and sewing machines was highlighted as an effective way to support individuals in gaining valuable skills that could lead to further education, employment opportunities and the ability to generate their own income.

These resources will also create opportunities for individuals to share skills with others in the community through informal tuition and peer learning.

To make this project possible, further donations will be required to purchase the necessary equipment and establish the training activities.

Additional funding will enable us to provide practical skills development opportunities that promote long-term financial stability, increased confidence and greater independence for individuals and families experiencing hardship.

By investing in future, these resources, donors will help create sustainable opportunities for education, skills development and income generation, strengthening the wellbeing and resilience of the wider community.



Partnerships Created

Reward International UK and Energize Care LTD worked with local people, volunteers, Islamic education tutors, local community leaders and supermarkets to identify vulnerable individuals and families who needed the support during Ramadan.

Volunteers from Reward International UK also helped manage food distributions, Iftari Food and recruiting new volunteers to help with the project.

These partnerships and contributions helped strengthen community support and increase the overall impact of the Ramadan Project 2026.
